Management Case Study	<p><u>Class Outline</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Understand & walk through the Case Study (CS) Exam via extracted exam questions. 2. Revise core topics of Competency subjects (E/P/F Pillars), hence closing knowledge gaps. 3. Getting familiar with pre-seen materials of the current CS exam (e.g., management accounting analysis, financial performance analysis, industry analysis and position audit, ethical analysis & main issues). 4. Past exam CS analysis, and exam questions and answers discussion. 5. Support students' self-attempts of CS exams and provide personalised feedback for 10 sets CS exam answers from students. 6. Mock exam questions and answers discussion for the current CS exam. 7. Identify hot topics of the current CS exam and getting ready for exam. 8.
